## Online Classes on Monday 11/30

To allow us to assess staff and student readiness to return to the building after Thanksgiving Break, all staff and students will do synchronous, online learning on Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup>. I have also made this request of our staff so that families may enjoy their break. **Here are the exceptions:**

If there is an emergency (hospitalization, etc.) that impacts a student, COVID-related or not, please text or call 832-335-3704 and leave a message, and I will get back to you as soon as possible.

## **Health and Safety During Holidays**

We wanted to share some information related to safety during the holiday season, because we want to empower families to make choices to keep themselves healthy and to keep our Hornet community safe.
